# Beyond Waste Fund

---

## Objective

\$14 million 4 year government investment in innovation in daily business operations that:

- Identifies waste avoidance opportunities
- Re-uses waste beneficially

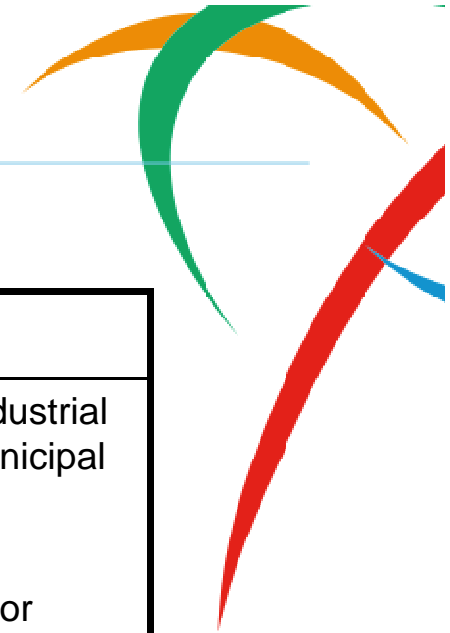
The overarching objective of the Fund is to assist meeting the Victorian Government's Towards Zero Waste targets by reducing the amount of waste sent to landfill through the avoidance of the generation of waste and/or reuse of waste.

<p>Projects that target Victorian-generated C&amp;I or C&amp;D waste</p> <p>Avoidance of the generation of waste, and reuse of waste</p> <p>Infrastructure and implementation projects</p> <p>Research and development and demonstration projects</p> <p>Knowledge and capacity-building projects</p>	<p>Projects relating to prescribed industrial waste (including asbestos) or municipal waste</p> <p>Recycling of waste, containment or treatment of waste or recovery of energy from waste</p> <p>Projects that commenced prior to the closure of the application period</p> <p>Projects that seek retrospective funding for work already completed at the time of application</p>

## Funds Timeline

### Round 1

- Expressions of Interest (EOI) Closed 13 December 2010
- Short list invited to complete an application
- Applications in development, closing date 30 May 2011
- Negotiation of Funding Agreements August 2011

### Round 2

- Expressions of Interest (EOI) will open July 2011

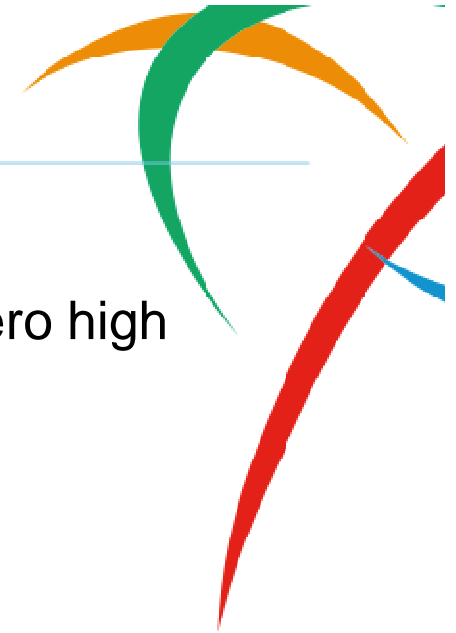

# HAZWASTEFund



Supporting Victorian Government's commitment of zero high hazard waste to landfill by 2020

- Category A      banned from landfill
- Category B      \$250/tonne
- Category C      \$70/tonne

Reinvestment of landfill levy for Prescribed Industrial Waste (PIW)

Around \$30 million available through the HazWaste Fund (2008-2012)

**Approximately \$20 million has been committed to projects**

# HAZWASTEFund



## Objectives:

- Reduce hazardous waste to landfill
- Reduce hazard category of hazardous waste disposed to landfill
- Increase remediation of contaminated soil

## Key investment areas are:

- Infrastructure and implementation projects
- Research and developments, and demonstration projects
- Knowledge and capacity-building projects
