Scope Existing Commercial Office Buildings,
located in Australia

Aim Reduce greenhouse gas emissions, by
improving building energy efficiency

Value Grants of \$50,000 to 500,000, for up to
50% of eligible project costs



A commercial office building is...

Office space used for a commercial purpose by the building owner



Must be

> 70% commercial office space

No minimum/maximum building size

Must satisfy definition before and after project

AusIndustry

Eligibility for grant support

Applicant must be

owner, part owner or agent

incorporated in Australia

not exempt from income tax

able to fund share of project

Project must

involve retrofitting/commissioning of an existing commercial office building

lead to significant expected reductions in greenhouse gas emissions

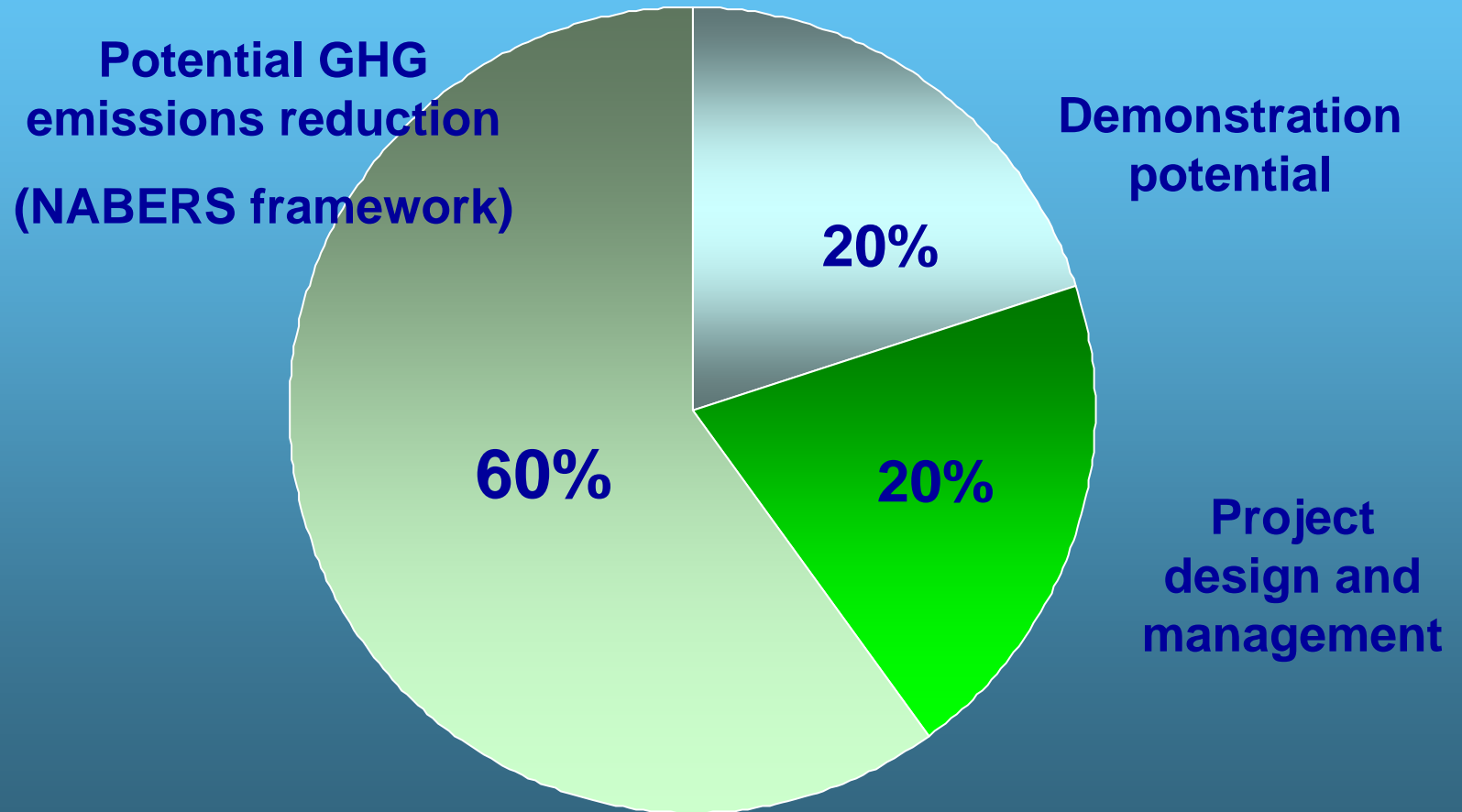
commence within specified timeframes

Sustainable Manufacturing

Re-tooling for Climate Change Program

Supports SME manufacturers

Projects must improve the energy and/or water efficiency of production processes

Grants of \$10,000 to \$500,000, for up to 50% of eligible project cost
