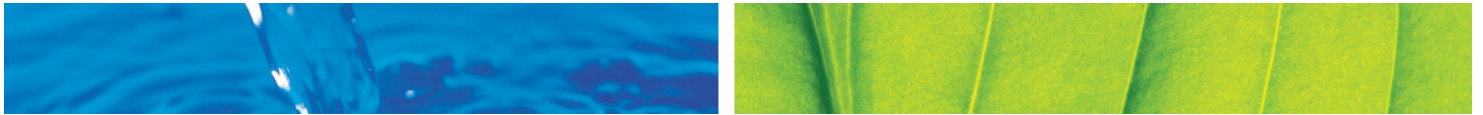
Hamish Reid, General Manager Strategy, South East Water Limited
