The safe, early and durable return to work of injured workers relies on participation of the employers, workers, doctors, insurers and other health practitioners. Employers must develop and document policies and procedures to form a Return to Work Program. This workshop will provide participants with an understanding of the key principles of an effective return to work program and how to develop policies and procedures that achieve results in early return to work and rehabilitation in the workplace.

KEY TOPICS

The workshop will outline practical methods to develop a systematic approach to dealing with the return to work of injured workers. Key Topics Include:

- Legal obligations
- How to develop a workplace RTW program, including;

 - Early commencement of injury management and early RTW
- Providing suitable duties
- Returning to work not to disadvantage workers
- Checklist for a workplace return to work program
- Implementing RTW programs in the workforce
- Utilising the WorkCover guideline return to work program in your workplace

Participants will gain an understanding of the benefits of documented Return to Work Programs, and how to implement effective policies and procedures for the rehabilitation of injured workers.
